



TIME WARNER CABLE KANSAS CITY ADDS PENTAGON CHANNEL ON DEMAND

ALEXANDRIA, VA: March 24, 2008 -- The Pentagon Channel recently expanded its Video on Demand (VOD) distribution to include the Kansas City Division of Time Warner Cable.

The Pentagon Channel, in collaboration with Kansas City's Time Warner Cable division, launched its largest line of VOD product for Time Warner. Local Time Warner subscribers now have access to the entire Pentagon Channel original documentary program series: RECON. RECON is available as a Free On Demand service. Users can find the Pentagon Channel programming under "Pentagon" in the Community section of their On Demand service.

"We are excited to leverage this emerging technology that provides our men and women in uniform another way to access important Pentagon Channel programming," said Allison Barber, Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Public Affairs – Internal Communications. "Harnessing this new technology augments the Pentagon Channel's ability to communicate relevant and timely military news and information to the men and women of the U.S. military." VOD systems allow users to select and watch video and clip content over a network. Part of an interactive television system, VOD systems either "stream" content, allowing viewing in real time, or "download" it bringing the program in its entirety to a set-top box before viewing starts. There is generally no cost to view VOD programming.
